JULY IS UV SAFETY MONTH





Americans spend the most time outdoors from 2pm-6pm, a peak time for harmful UV rays. Eyes are most at risk between 8am-10am and 2pm-4pm.



Studies show that long term exposure to bright sunlight may cause the risk of cataracts and growths on the eye, including cancer. UV rays reflected off sand and water can cause eyes to sunburn, potentially resulting in temporary blindness in just a few
