

Good Days Program: 2025 Funding Issue

In the past, patients with Medicare and Medicare Advantage plans were eligible to enroll in the Good Days Program, a national nonprofit, charitable organization, that assisted with offsetting the cost of the patient responsibility for injections.

Unfortunately, current notifications indicate that the Good Days Program is experiencing funding challenges for 2025 and cannot continue to provide assistance.

As participating providers in the Medicare Program, Eye Care Specialists, and Northeastern Eye Institute are required by federal law to collect unmet deductible, copays and coinsurance amounts for Medicare and Medicare Advantage beneficiaries. To remain compliant with Medicare requirements, patients will continue to be responsible for their patient responsibility at the time of their visit.

While this may prove to be a financial concern for patients, we strongly encourage you to continue with scheduled appointments to support your eye care health and mitigate any potential loss of vision that could result from discontinuing treatment.
